**Police Report**

Chief Elliott reported there were 22 calls for service, 441 Self-Initiated Activities, 8 Traffic Enforcement Activities, and 9 Agency Assists for the reporting period. Training for the month included: Police Law Monthly Online Training; Online Training via Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board; KMS (Lexipol) On-line Training, Yearly firearms qualification. Officers engaged special assignments of; Talking with Annawan Alba Women's club Scams, Fun Days parade, and Obtained arrest for violation orders of protection. The Police department received a \$500 donation from the Annawan Alba Women's Club. Full report is on file in the village office.

**Parks and Recreation Report**

Kelsey reported the Community Center had 3 free and 6 paid rentals in May as well as 3 rentals for the Shelter House.

The Community Center has 74 members between single and family.

The Annawan Alba Women's Club made a \$1,000 donation to the Community Center.

Fun Days was a success, Kiddie Tractor pull was canceled due to the Vendor not being present. Next year we will need more trash cans and possibly more recycling bins.

Little Miss Village of Annawan Pageant went well. Little Miss was Kinley Rico, 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up: Lyla Anderson, 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner Up: Hadley Dedecker. The Little Miss and her fellow elected runners got to help at the car show, enjoy games in the park, participate in the parade, and introduce themselves before the Joe Stamm Band.

Baseball teams and schedules are to be released this week. Teams with older kids have already started practicing. All games begin in the end of May and will go until mid-July.
